# Nishorgo Support Project Landscape Development Fund Grants Program Closing Report

#### 1. Introduction

The Landscape Development Fund (LDF) Grants were made to the eight Co-Management Committees (CMCs) that are operational in the five pilot Protected Areas (PA) and their surrounding landscapes. Main objective of these grants was to provide support to the CMCs for implementing broad based community initiatives that will create improved community incentives for biodiversity conservation and economic growth.

The USAID/Dhaka approved the grant operational document entitled "Competitive Grants Manual for Landscape Development Fund (LDF) Grant Program". It provided program guidelines and operational procedures for the Grant projects. The Grants projects were managed by IRG via its subcontractors RDRS in Northern Sites and CODEC in Southern Sites.

Main responsibility for the implementing LDF Grants projects was with the following NSP supported eight Co-Management Committees (CMC):

#### A. Northern Sites:

- 1. Lawachara National Park CMC
- 2. Rema Kelanga Wildlife Sanctuary CMC
- 3. Satchuri National Park CMC

#### **B. Southern Sites:**

- 4. Teknaf Game Reserve
  - 4.1. Teknaf CMC
  - 4.2. Whykheong CMC
  - 4.3. Shilkhali CMC
- 5. Chunati Wildlife Sanctuary
  - 5.1 Chunati CMC
  - 5.2 Banshkhali CMC

#### 2. LDF Grants Project Approval Process

Each of the CMC Chairperson submitted project proposal and application to the Grants Review Committee (GRC), which consisted with following members:

- The Chief of Party of IRG Nishorgo Support Project or his designate
- The Forest Department's Project Director for the Nishorgo Support Project or his designate, and
- The IRG Grants Coordinator

The following staffs were designated as observers:

- The Regional Coordinator North sites
- The Regional Coordinator South sites
- USAID's CTO

The project proposals were reviewed in two stages; initially scrutinized by the Regional Grants Officer and by the IRG Grants Coordinator to ensure that they meet minimum standards.

At the second –stage all the project proposals were formally reviewed and comments sent in writing by the members of the Grants Review Committee. The GRC members finalized grants project proposals based on the strategic fit with the objectives of the LDF and based on the best value determinations.

The GRC decisions were approved by the Cognizant Technical Officer, USAID.

After getting approval from USAID, the Chief of Party communicated award letters, along with *LDF Grant Award Acceptance agreement*, to the grantee for finalizing terms and conditions including the fund disbursement, reporting schedules, evaluation plans and budget.

At the mutually convenient dates, the final documents were signed by the Chief of Party as grant providing authority and CMC Chairperson as grantee acceptance in the presence of two witnesses (e.g. Regional Coordinator from implementing partner NGO and IRG Grants Coordinator).

## 3. Projects Approved Under LDF Grant Program

During the period from April 2007 to June 2008 IRG/USAID approved **36 projects** (Annex # 1) amounting **BDT 10,863,150** as USAID LDF grant where a total of **BDT 8,989,303** was spent and **BDT 2,228,981** was budgeted as committee contribution.

## 4. Projects Implemented and Changes Made

Of the total 36 approved projects, 28 projects were implemented with donor fund amounting BDT 8,560,138 (against the approved budget of BDT 8,776,615). In addition, the CMCs spent BDT 2,105,547 as part of their community contribution (Annex # 2).

The experience of implementing the LDF Grants Projects was very much challenging for all the parties involved, especially the CMCs as their new found involvement in the whole project implementation process.

#### 4.1 Time Extension

Due to unavoidable circumstances the projects time were extended in some cases as per the requests made by some of the CMCs (see Annex # 3 for details).

### 4.2 Additional Costs

Two projects were granted additional funding (Annex # 4). This included the deepening of Mochoni Lake, Teknaf Game Reserve (LDF # 5) by providing additional BDT 208,000; and modification in the design of bridges in Remakalenga Wildlife Sanctuary due to increase in timber prices (LDF # 9) - by providing additional funds of BDT 181,002.

#### 5. Projects Terminated/Partially Implemented

Due to unavoidable circumstances, the field works for eight projects were delayed. Therefore, the LDF Grants authority issued termination notices to all concerned

chairpersons. In the absence of any satisfactory response these projects were terminated finally (see Annex # 5). The total amount of **eight terminated projects** was **BDT 2,086,535** as USAID LDF grant and **BDT 123,434** as committee contribution. One of the eight projects (LDF # 17 - Establishment of a Passenger Shed beside Chandichara Mazar Road & Shops in front of Satchari Information Center) was terminated in part. Similarly the LDF # 21 project (Construction of Passenger Shed & Shops from LDF in front of Fulbari Tea Estate Approach Road) was terminated partially after the construction works was started. These two projects had made expenditure of **BDT 429,165.** 

### 6. Periodical Reporting

As per their agreements the Grantee provided IRG with monthly/bi-monthly progress reports which included project activities implementation status and financial status as per the Grant report formats.

## 7. Closing Report

Each of the projects Grantee submitted closing reports which included inter alia activities implemented, objective achievement status and impacts, and financial reports. All the projects conducted internal audits and submitted the audit reports.

#### 8. Conclusion

The LDF Grants projects provided generally two types of major impacts viz. 1) created broad based community benefits; and 2) enhanced CMC's management capacity thereby enabling them to access similar grants from other donors. Both the impacts would eventually augment concerned people's participation in biodiversity conservation in the protected areas.
